Awards & Prizes

Up to 8 teams will be selected as finalists and will receive an **\$8,000 award** to facilitate full participation in the 2025 Blue Skies Forum at NASA's Armstrong Flight Research Center in May 2025.

Winners will be offered the opportunity to intern within NASA's Aeronautics Research Mission Directorate in the academic year following the Forum.
